Growing God's kingdom

There are some exciting things happening within our Benefice and I want to celebrate all the opportunities we have as disciples of Christ to grow God's kingdom by following Jesus' example of meeting people where they are to sow and nurture seeds faith.

One of the new opportunities is that the benefice has joined a pilot scheme for Bubble Church which is aimed at families with children under 7. It is a 30 min service of bible stories told with puppets, action songs and an activity. I am really excited about trying this short interactive service aimed at the families we all want to bring into church but who often struggle with the length and style of our usual Sunday services. The aim of Bubble Church is that it is seen as



a church service in its own right and it teaches families the importance of coming together on the Sabbath, that is why it is held on a Sunday, in a church.

Thank you to those who have already volunteered to be part of the team, welcoming, leading and working the computer, if anyone else is interested please contact Rev Melissa there are lots of different roles. There is a training day in London on 11th November for those interested in leading and able to make it and then after that I would like to get everyone who is interested together to discuss our options for where and when so please let me know if you are interested so I can let you know when we will be meeting.

Some people have raised concerns that it won't be bringing children into the 'normal' Sunday service. In one way, its not meant to, this will be a 'normal' service for those families who attend and it may be the only service for some families who are unable to come in the morning due to family, sport or work commitments. Also Bubble Church will be no more than once a month in any of our churches so it can be used as an opportunity to build relationships with families and invite them to other services and as the children and parents grow in age and faith they will hopefully look to attend other services which can support them in that stage of their faith journey. Many of the families are unchurched so as yet don't have a relationship with God which makes them want to prioritise Sunday morning worship. We need to help build those relationships so they feel like they belong.

So I encourage you to not look at any one service as being the 'main' or 'normal' service. If you want the service you attend to grow then invite people to come with you. If they don't want to come then we will always struggle to reach them, but if they want to but can't then we need to look for an alternative for them to enable them to engage. We may at times need to be willing to change our routine but let's look for the opportunities we might have to worship together, share our faith with someone new and help bring them into God's presence. And this is not just about families and Bubble Church it is about adults and midweek services, home groups and fellowship groups. As I often say to schools "when we listen to God and work together we can do amazing things".

Let's see what we can grow together.
